



Practical Submissions required to achieve Horses Helping Humans Certification

1. Submit a safety presentation (~ 5mins)
2. Submit a presentation of you giving the 'Which Horse or Pony are You?' introduction / spiel. (5-10 min)
3. Submit the jelly belly breathing exercise presentation. (~3-5 min)
4. Submit a presentation of each horse which will be used in the program doing all the tasks in the program (& resubmit sections if necessary).
5. Submit a presentation of you "teaching all the tasks".
6. Submit presentation of facilities, to ensure they comply with safety, etc.
7. Provide documentation required as per Licensee Evaluation Form in the "Template Forms" section of the HHH Trello Board.

At this point, provided that the requirements on the Licensee Evaluation form have been addressed, the facilitator can now run the HHH program.

8. Within 6 months facilitators need to attain the 'Chris Corbidge certification' as well.
NOTE this certification does not need to be completed with a horse being used in the Horses Helping Humans Program.

Head Facilitators / Licensees need to pass all of the above 8 points.

They head off the organisation and are able to run HHH sessions unsupervised.

Head Assistant Facilitators need to pass points 1 to 5, & 7 above.

They are able to run HHH sessions unsupervised.

Assistant Facilitators need to pass points 1, 3 & 4 above. They are never to run HHH sessions without the supervision of a Head Facilitator / Head Assistant Facilitator / Licensee.

At no time is anyone to leave a client alone or unengaged.
